The No Child Left behind (NCLB) School Reports contain information on each school in the district. There is also an overall district report. Each report contains assessments and accountability information about our schools and the school district.

Under assessments, the percentages of students who are advanced, proficient, basic, and below basic in reading, math and science are noted in the reports by school and district level.

Under accountability, the percentage of students participating in the tests, total percentage of students advanced and proficient is indicated along with the annual measurable objectives (AMO) set forth by the state of South Dakota to determine our annual yearly progress (AYP).
