Subject: NCLB School Reports and information compiled from the Dakota Step Testing Results

from the spring of 2013

The No Child Left behind (NCLB) School Reports contain information on each school in the district. There is also an overall district report. Each report contains assessments and accountability information about our schools and the school district.

Under assessments, the percentages of students who are advanced, proficient, basic, and below basic in reading, math and science are noted in the reports by school and district level.

Under accountability, the percentage of students participating in the tests, total percentage of students advanced and proficient is indicated along with the annual measurable objectives (AMO) set forth by the state of South Dakota to determine our annual yearly progress (AYP). The 2013 Report Card reflects implementation under South Dakota's new accountability system. The system is based on a 100-point <u>School Performance Index</u>, or SPI. The SPI consists of multiple indicators to measure a school's performance. Two distinct indexes are used: 1) one for elementary/middle school accountability, and 2) one for high school accountability.
