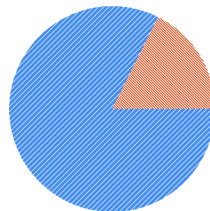

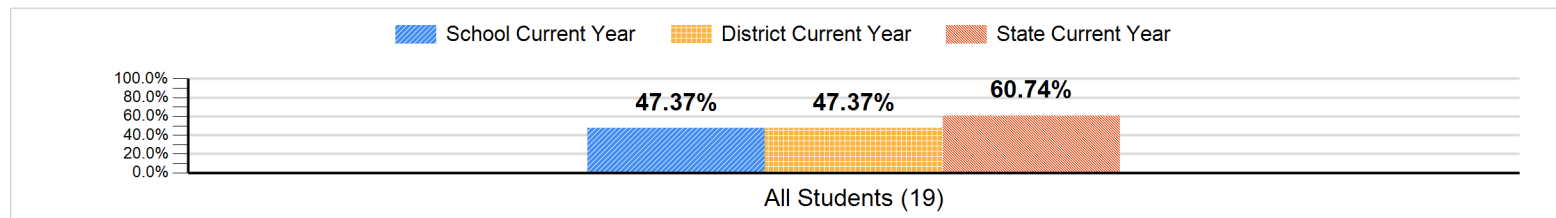
Student Population

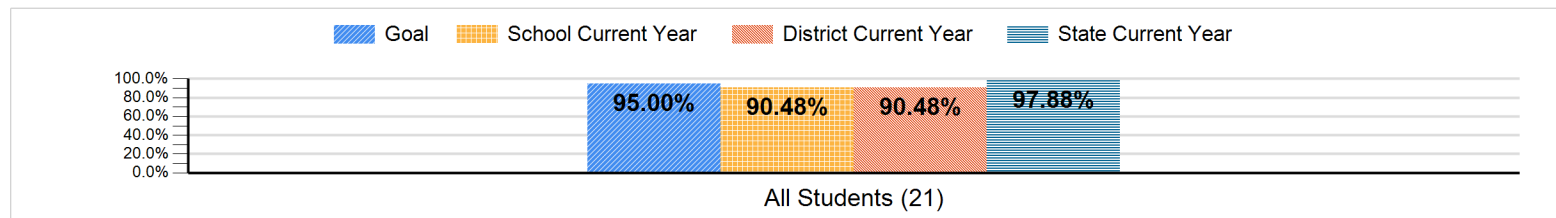

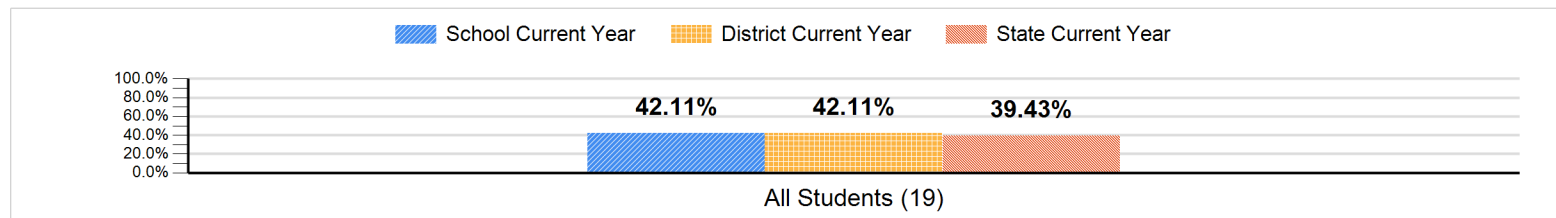

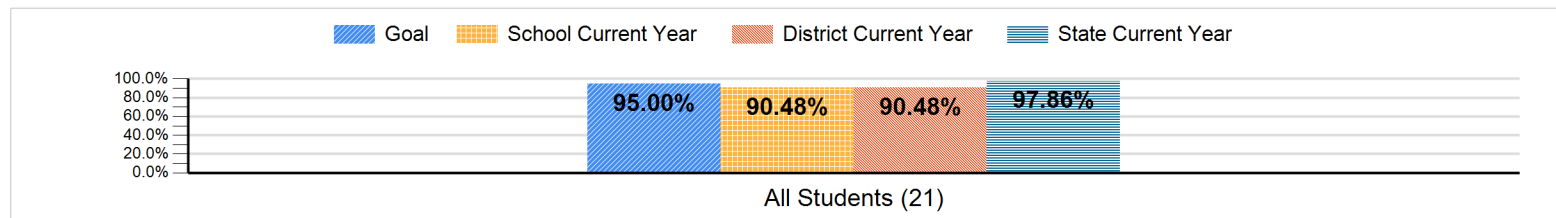

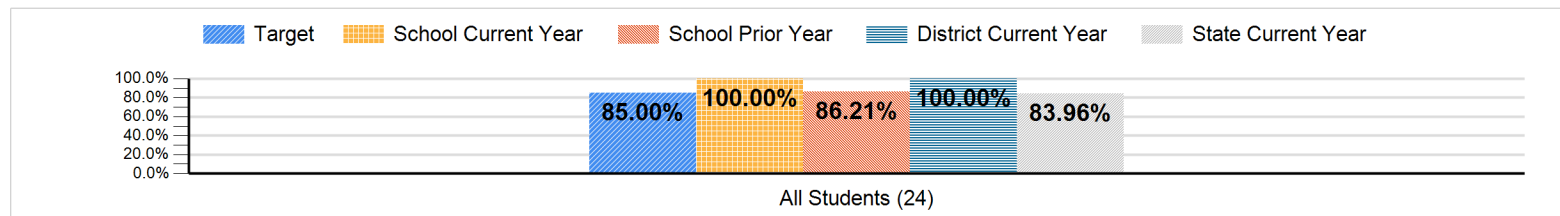

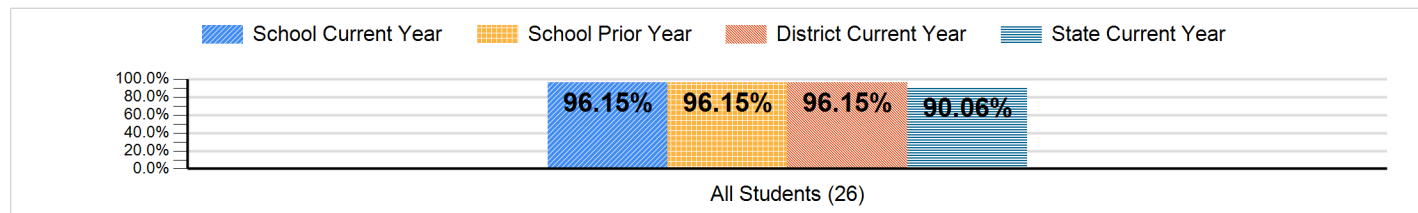
